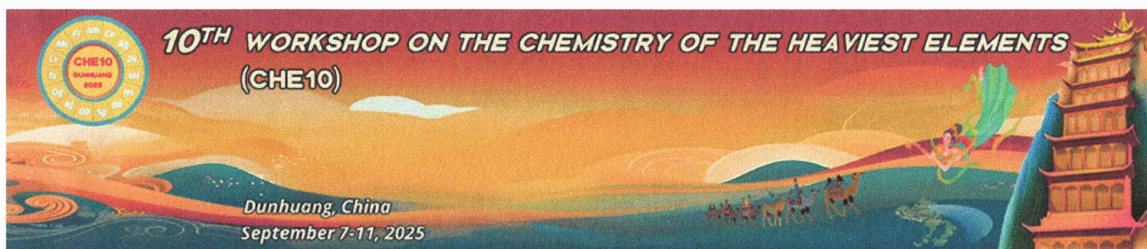


10th Workshop on the Chemistry of the Heaviest Elements (CHE10)

1 Venue & Travel to Dunhuang

The workshop will be held in Dunhuang, Gansu, China.

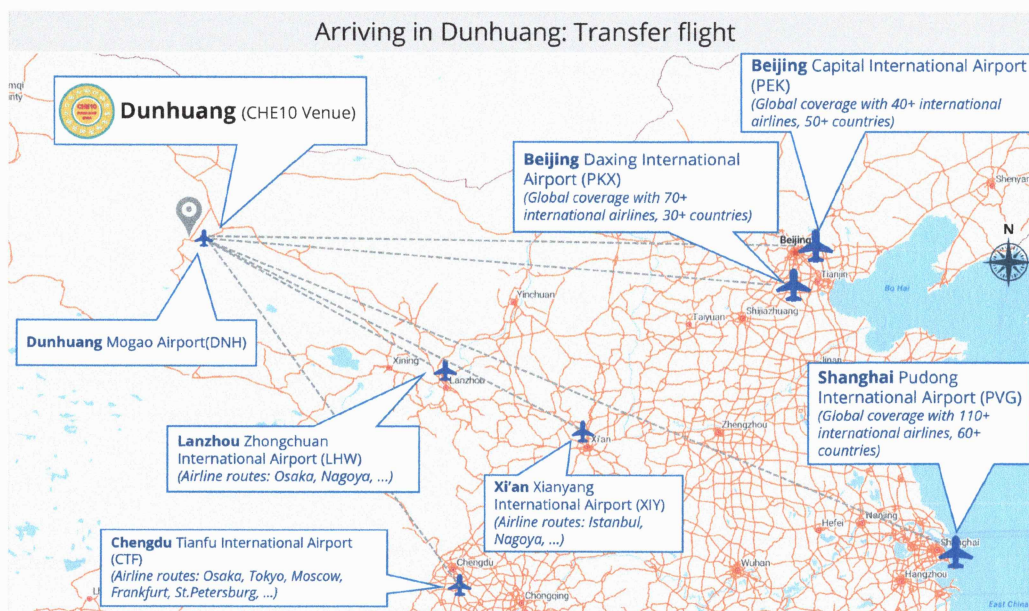
For international participants arriving by air, the nearest international airport is “Dunhuang Airport” (IATA-Code: DNH). Dunhuang Airport operates domestic flights only, with direct routes to/from Beijing, Shanghai, Chengdu, Xi'an, Lanzhou, etc. Currency exchange is NOT available at Dunhuang Airport.

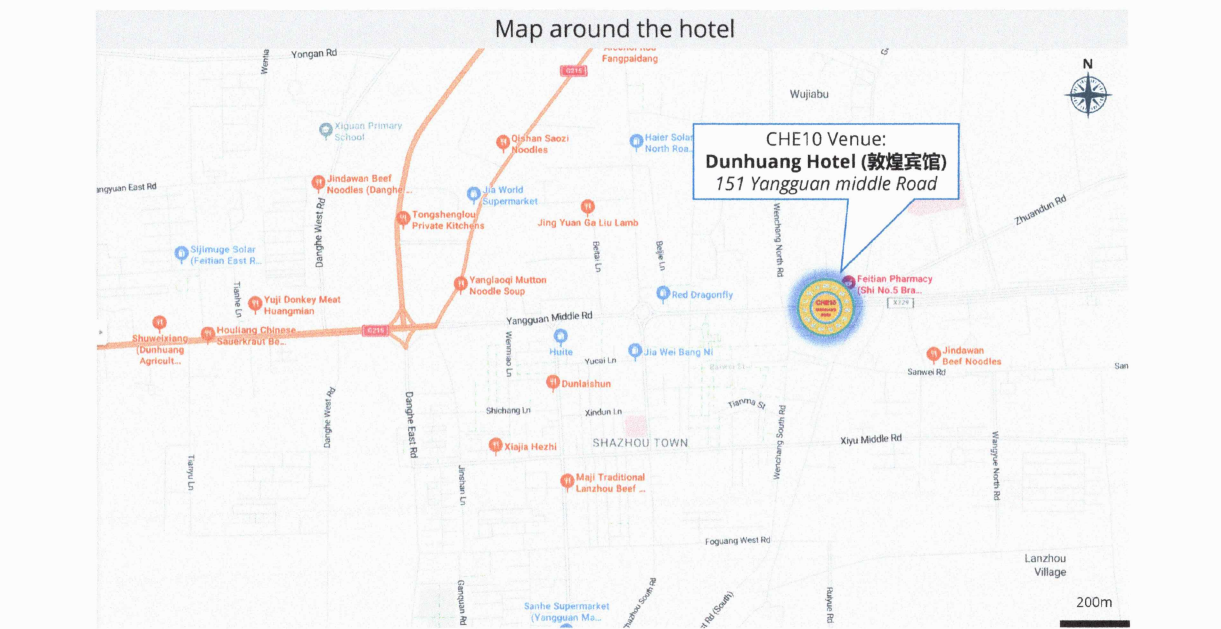
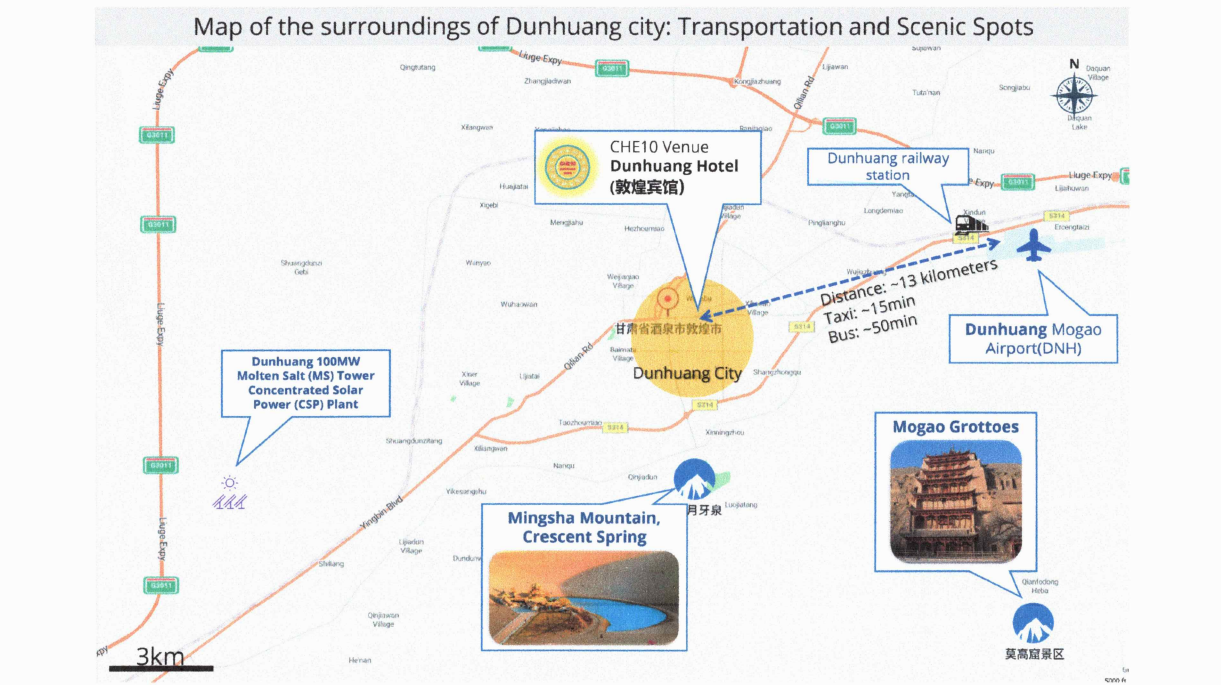
The workshop venue is the ”Dunhuang Hotel” (敦煌宾馆).

The conference venue is located approximately 13 km from the airport. If you provide us with your flight arrival details in a timely manner (by replying to this email with your flight number and date), we will arrange buses to pick you up at the airport and transfer you to Dunhuang Hotel. Volunteers holding signage with the CHE10 logo will be stationed at the airport exit. You may also choose taxis (~15 minutes) or public buses (~50 minutes).

- Time for each oral presentation: **20 min** (15 min for presentation, 5 min for discussion).

8 Some key travel tips in Dunhuang

- Weather & Clothing

Temperature: Warm days (20 - 28 °C / 68 - 82 °F) but cooler nights (10 - 15 °C / 50 - 59 °F).

Pack: Light layers for daytime, a jacket/sweater for evenings, sunglasses, and a wide-brimmed hat for sun protection.

Footwear: Comfortable walking shoes (especially for the sand dunes and hiking).

- Sun & Desert Protection

Strong UV rays: Use high-SPF sunscreen, lip balm, and reapply often.

Dust & Wind: Bring a scarf or mask (sandstorms can occur).

Hydration: Carry water - dry climate increases dehydration risk.

- Cultural & Practical Tips

Respect local customs: No flash photography in Mogao Caves.

Cash & Payments: Some remote areas may prefer cash (though cards/WeChat Pay are widely accepted).

- Altitude

Dunhuang is ~1,200 m above sea level - no major altitude sickness risk, but take it easy if sensitive.
